

FLINTROCK 4-H CLUB
Eligibility Card & Member in Good Standing Requirements

Eligibility Card – You must meet these Rockingham County requirements to receive your eligibility card. Eligibility cards are necessary to compete in 4-H district level (and higher) horseshows.

- * Participate in a MINIMUM of 2 community service projects
- * Attend at least 50% of the club monthly meetings (5 meetings)
- * Have all necessary forms filled out

Must complete at least 2 of the following:

- * Completed Project Record Book, submitted for judging
- * Perform Club/County Level Public Speaking
- * Perform Club/County Level Demonstration/Presentation
- * Artistic Expression Contest – which includes: horse craft, horse painting, horse poster, horse photography, horse essay, horse creative writing and horse poetry
- * Hippology Contest
- * Horse Bowl Contest
- * Horse Judging Contest
- * Horsemanship Camp at Millstone
- * Horse District Retreat/Clinic
- * Active on County, District or State youth council

If a 4-H'er joins after January 1, they will receive a waiver for the first year and be allowed to receive their eligibility card.

Member in Good Standing – You must meet these requirements, in addition to the county requirements listed above, to be a member in good standing. Being a member in good standing is necessary to vote for or be elected as a club officer, and to receive benefit from club funds for education or competition.

- * Officers (once elected) must attend at least 75% of the club monthly meetings (8 meetings)
- * At least one service project must be a trash pick-up each year.
- * All service projects must be 4-H projects that are approved by the leaders.
- * Participate in all fundraisers including the annual horse show, which has the following requirements:
 - Sell sponsorships for booklet – 1 show or division OR 2 classes
 - Bring 12 canned drinks or bottled waters to sell
 - Bring individually wrapped desserts or assigned condiments
 - Help with concessions set-up (night before) OR clean-up (after show)
 - Work assigned time in concessions AND on gate

In the event that a member is showing or has a conflict on the show date and cannot perform these duties, they are responsible for finding a friend or family member to fulfill their duties.
